Date	Verse	Meditation Passage
1.3.2016	2 Corinthians 5:20	20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.
1.10.2016	Luke 8:15	15 As for that in the good soil, they are those who, hearing the word, hold it fast in an honest and good heart, and bear fruit with patience.
1.17.2016	Luke 10:36-37	36 Which of these three, do you think, proved to be a neighbor to the man who fell among the robbers? 37 He said, "The one who showed him mercy." And Jesus said to him, "You go, and do likewise."
1.24.2016	Luke 14:11	11 For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.
1.31.2016	Luke 14: 23-24	23 And the master said to the servant, 'Go out to the highways and hedges and compel people to come in, that my house may be filled. 24 For I tell you, none of those men who were invited shall taste my banquet.'
2.7.2016	Luke 19:26-27	26 'I tell that to everyone who has, more will be given, but from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away. 27 But as for these enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, bring them here and slaughter them before me.'
2.14.2016	Luke 19:41-42	41 And when he drew near and saw the city, he wept over it, 42 saying, "Would that you, even you, had known on this day the things that make for peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes."
2.21.2016	Luke 20:17-18	17 But he looked directly at them and said, "What then is this that is written: " 'The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone'? 18 Everyone who falls on that stone will be broken to pieces, and when it falls on anyone, it will crush him."
2.28.2016	Luke 22: 19-20	19 And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." 20 And likewise the cup after they had eaten saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood."
3.6.2016	Luke 22:41-42	41 And he withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, 42 saying "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done."
3.13.2016	Luke 23:22-23	22 A third time he said to them, "Why, what evil has he done? I have found in him no guilt deserving death. I will therefore punish and release him." 23 But they were urgent, demanding with loud cries that he should be crucified. And their voices prevailed.
3.20.2016	Luke 23:46-47	46 Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last. 47 Now when the centurion saw what had taken place, he praised God, saying, "Certainly this man was innocent!"

3.27.2016	Luke 24:4-5	4 While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel. 5 And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?"
4.3.2016	Luke 24:27	27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.
4.10.2016	Acts 1:7-8	7 He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. 8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
4.17.2016	Acts 2:38-39	38 And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our calls to himself."
4.24.2016	Acts 4:32	32 Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common.
5.1.2016	Acts 3:19-21	19 Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out, 20 that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus, 21 whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago.
5.8.2016	Acts 4:29-30	29 And now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to your servants to continue to speak your word with all boldness, 30 while you stretch out your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the name of your holy servant Jesus."
5.15.2016	Acts 5:9 & 11	9 But Peter said to her, "How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out." 11 And great fear came upon the whole church and upon all who heard of these things.
5.22.2016	Acts 5:41-42	41 Then they left the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the name. 42 And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they did not cease teaching and preaching that the Christ is Jesus.
5.29.2016	Acts 6:1 & 7	1 Now in these days when the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint by the Hellenists arose against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. 7 And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests become obedient to the faith.
